

#### **Year in Review**

- Landscaping enhancements
  - Pool perimeter

  - Replacement of dead cypress on main entry berm and cypress at front berm
  - Erosion management at rear of pool
  - Enhanced weed control, mulch on common grounds
  - Expanded plantings of annuals at front entrance and pool

### **Architectural Committee**

## Reserve Modeling

- Reserves are balances held in order to pay for large capital expenses both planned and unforeseen
- Planned means on a expected cycle based on expected life of physical asset or equipment (resurfacing of pool deck, replacement of recirculating pumps, etc.)
- Based on engineering study: 1996 (GEC, \$560) and formal financial analysis: 2011 (McLaughlin and Crucini)

# Reserve growth: Too Fast, Too Slow, Just Right?

- Net income adds to reserves while capital expenditure depletes them; striking a balance requires adjustments from time-to-time
- In 2012, grounds budget at pool was reallocated to Highland View.
- Reserves are now declining.
- Dues increase \$118.75 to \$125.00 per quarter (+2,025 per year for the budget)
- Combined with change on Murray Lane quarterly dues fall by \$2.50 per quarter!
